

Holiday Activity Course Kit List – Easter 2019

The following list is a guide to the equipment and clothing your son/daughter will require to participate fully in the course/s they have chosen:

Course	Requirements
Art & Craft	Apron / old shirt
Climbing	Trainers
Cookery	Apron / old shirt and two Tupperware style containers to take items home in
Fencing	Tracksuit trousers and trainers – no leggings please
Football & Football Jnrs	Football boots, trainers, shin guards (essential) , warm / waterproof clothing
Health & Beauty	Small towel, brush and comb
Hockey	Trainers, warm / waterproof clothing, shin guards (essential) . A gum shield is highly recommended
Multi-Activity	Warm / waterproof clothing, indoor / outdoor footwear. Swimming kit will be required but not on first day of the courses, a weekly timetable is available to view when dropping children off
Multi-Sports	Trainers, warm / waterproof clothing, swimming kit (not required on first day)
Racket Sports	Trainers, warm / waterproof clothing, rackets are provided (you may bring your own if you wish, but please mark this clearly with your child's name)
Rowing	Trainers, swimming kit (for a swim test on the first day) and a change of clothing just in case!
Survival Adventure Skills	Camouflaged combat clothing is provided, but please wear suitable clothing which may get dirty, sturdy shoes or boots are required along with an alternative pair of trainers / shoes and spare socks
Table Tennis	Trainers

If the course you have chosen is not mentioned above, then your son/daughter does not require any specialist-clothing etc. If they are outdoors on an AM course, a change of clothes for PM may be required if the weather is inclement. **All items of clothing should be clearly named.**
