

UCAS Timeline for Sixth Form



YEAR 12

Date	Activity
November - December UNIFROG	Identification of pathways, recording of competencies and activities. Initial course options explored.
January	Identification of potential Oxbridge applicants. UCAS Launch event to parents and students.
January - July UNIFROG	As above plus course searches and personal statement preparation. Plan open day visits for the summer. Engagement with the chosen subject area is key at this stage. Students should identify those activities that will support their application and have a plan in place, additional reading, MOOCs, work experience etc.
March	Oxbridge Evening.
May - June	Online Parent talk - A first look at the UCAS application form Internal Exams. Students register on UCAS and complete part one of their application
June - July	Predicted grades published for UCAS references. Open Day visits. Apply for admissions tests where relevant
Summer Task	It is the responsibility of students in conjunction with their parents to return to school with a full second draft of their personal statement for the subject they plan to study.

YEAR 13

July - September	Students firm up course choices and complete remaining sections of UCAS application. Students should also ensure that where applicable they are entered for the appropriate entrance exam.
09 October	School deadline for early applicants.
15 October	UCAS early applicants deadline.
04 December	School internal deadline for all remaining applicants.
13 January	UCAS final deadline.
February - March	Student finance opens. Internal mock exams.
March - April	Students to make decisions on firm and insurance decisions. Potential to visit universities again after offers have been received.
May - June	Deadline for students to make firm and insurance decisions.
August	Results day and confirmation of places or entry into Clearing.
